




**WHAT'S THE BIG DEAL ABOUT LOVE?

GAME: GET IN THAT GROUP!

This is a fun and easy game that can be played with anywhere from 10-50 kids.

Supplies: None

Directions: For this game, students will begin by skipping, jumping, walking, etc. around the room. The leader then calls out a number and everyone must get into a group of that number. For instance if the number 7 is called out, everyone must find 6 other people and stand with them. Whoever is not in a group is out. The last 2 people win!

This game should last about 10 minutes!

*****If there are less than 10 students and leaders:*****

Play this game a couple of times. You can even have students call out a number!

Gal. 6:1-2 // Exodus 20:12
4. Is it ok to date someone who is not a Christian?
2 Cor. 6:14-15 // 1 Cor. 15:33
- If you date someone who is not a Christian, how can they help point you towards God?
5. Do you believe in soul mates? Is there a "right one" for everyone?
6. All you need is love- yes or no?
Psalm 16:5-11 // Matt. 11:28-31

* Feel free to ask other questions that are relevant to the topic being discussed!
